Scheduled itinerary:

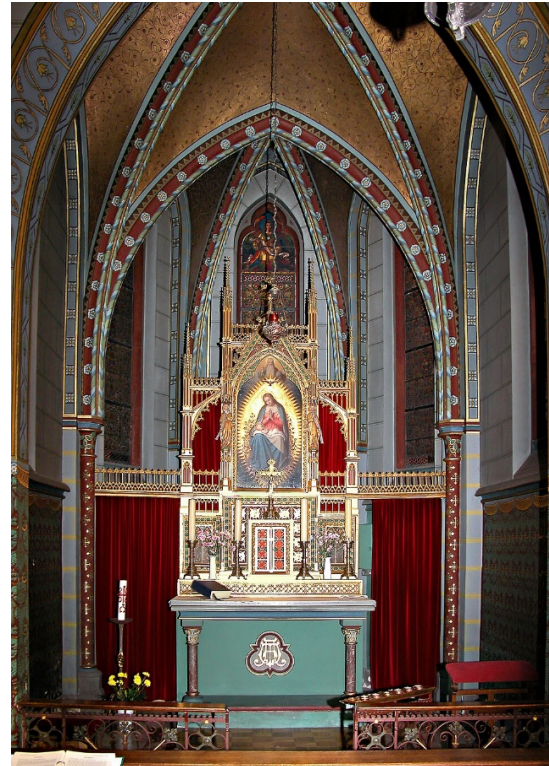
10:30 a.m.: Holy Mass at St. Paulus, Bernhardstr. 42.

Afterward: Ride on public bus 63 to the “Blaues Wunder” bridge—followed by a communal picnic in a nearby wooded area—please bring your own food and drinks and share them with one another!

Afterward: Pilgrimage through three chapels near the banks of the Elbe to Pillnitz Palace.

Closing prayer service with a sacramental blessing—ends around 6:30 p.m.

The pilgrimage will take place if at least 10 people have confirmed their participation (please contact Deacon Peter!).



Along the way, we'll visit: the historic (now Protestant) St. Mary's Church "Maria am Wasser," the chapel of the HohenEichen Retreat House, the romantic Neo-Gothic chapel "Maria am Wege," which was once endowed by the Saxon royal family, and, to conclude, the spacious castle chapel in Pillnitz. Four very different places of worship—representing the spiritual diversity and Christian heritage of Dresden-Hosterwitz and -Pillnitz. Walking distance: just under 10 km!
